Specially trained clinicians provide defusing and debriefing, trauma intervention, and psychological first aid.



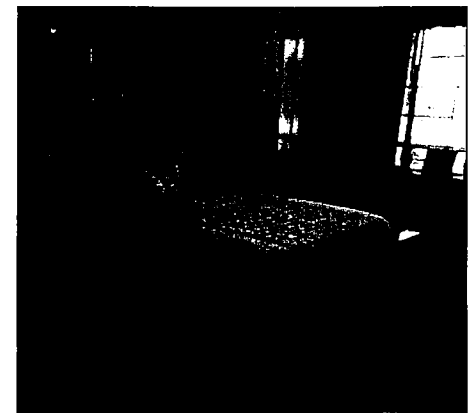
